Mahindra Group announces The Mahindra Kabira Festival

Mystical music with Kabir stalwarts and much more in Varanasi 4th - 6th November, 2016

New Delhi, October, 2016: In the simple lyrical verses of Kabir lie the answers to our most complex spiritual questions. And for three days in November, the Darbhanga and Assi ghats of Varanasi will reverberate with the soulful music inspired by Kabir, the enigmatic 15th century mystic-poet. The Mahindra Kabira Festival will run from 4th to 6th November, 2016, offer a haunting and immersive experience of imbibing Kabir's philosophies and the lyrical aspect of his teachings through a programme which will celebrate Kabir's passion and verse linking them inextricably with the fascinating spirit of Varanasi, his birthplace.

The experience shall be amplified with languid afternoon literature sessions around Kabir and his philosophy, the taste of local food down the streets of the city and wondrous musical evenings as the sun sets on the Ganga.

An opening reception on the evening of the 4th of November will feature a spectacular local group from Varanasi singing songs of Kabir followed by a poetry and "in conversation" session with **Shabnam Virmani** & members of the **Kabir Project**. Guests will be treated to a grand opening dinner on the terraces of the Brij Rama Palace overlooking the Ganga glittering with the lights of the city, its gravitas heightened by the boats dotting it.

Morning Music at the Darbhanga Ghat

Begin your day at Mahindra Kabira with an invigorating Morning Music Programme, featuring Kabir stalwarts such as **Prahlad Tipanya** & **Shabnam Virmani** along the with brilliant Varanasi-based groups such as **Taal Kutchery** who perform on the Darbhanga Ghat in the mornings of both festival days.

Literature Sessions on the Ganga

Perfectly coupled with the languor of lazy afternoons would be Mahindra Kabira's literary sessions on themes around Kabir's life, lyrics and teachings, held on the terraces of the Brij Rama Palace. Breathe in the scents of this incomparable city, sip your chai, bite into your samosa, stare at the omniscient river all around as the likes of **Amish Tripathi**, **Vyomesh Shukla**, **Yatindra Mishra** (The Kabir Project) bring alive Kabir for you through the passion and verse of discourse and debate.





Heritage & Chaat Food Walk

Varanasi is a food haven, a juggernaut of sharp bursting flavours, of delectable melt-in-your mouth *kachoris*, *chaat*, *parathas*, *malai-mar-ke* (topped with cream) *lassi* and *paan*. Follow the food trail from the famous Kashi Chaat Bhandar to the little stalls of Kachori Gali behind Kashi Vishwanath Temple, the shops selling pakoras and everything else on Vishwanath Gali. Visit Kabir Mat, Sankat Mochan Temple, see the weavers at work translating fantasy into golden reality and more. Live out the history of one of the world's oldest cities, experience its overpowering character through specially guided tours curated by the city's best tour guides.

Evening Music on Assi Ghat

Mahindra Kabira days will end with their swashbuckling finale – get onto boats from the Brij Rama Palace to travel to Assi Ghat, the destination of the Mahindra Kabira evening music programme featuring the likes of **Pt. Rajan & Sajan Mishra**, **Mir Mukhtiyar Ali**, **Kabir Café**, **Vidya Shah**, **Shabnam Virmani** & more. In an unforgettable tableau, unique to Varanasi, the musicians will be staged on the river facing the *ghat* where audiences will be seated. Give in to the moment and let your senses experience the magic of music under the stars, take in the ambience of the bustling *ghats*rich with the aroma of food stalls, coloured by Varanasi craftware and much more.
